4th of July Pool Party



I must say I was very pleased with the effort my staff made in order to over come these odds. I was also pleased to have the new chipping area open in time for these young men to utilize during this event.

Our greens aerification process went as smoothly as we could ask. Working conditions were tough with heat indexes reaching 103*F, but my staff persevered as normal. We verticut on Sunday evening and Monday morning then core aerified throughout the day on Monday. On Tuesday we had contractors come in with specialized machines to perform a process called DryJecting. These machines force sand into the profile of our green creating an excellent environment for root development. Both of these processes improve the growing conditions of our greens and promote long term health benefits. We appreciate everyone's patience as we work hard to return our greens to their normal conditions.

The dress code applies through the golf course and all practice areas.




