
Golf Maintenance News

I would like to thank you all for respecting our request to use the mats on the driving range while waiting for our over seed to grow-in. Our over seeded areas germinated faster this year than I have ever seen in my career. We had viable plant life only 4 days after seeding! Usually we don't have this kind of growth until 7-10 days after seeding. I attribute this to minimizing traffic on these areas as well as having warm temperatures and rainfall. Please note that the chipping area adjacent to the driving range and #16 tees have not been over seeded this year.

I have had some questions about the drainage project between #5 and #6 regarding the water holding in that area. The goal of the project was to replace the failed catch basins and replace the failed drainage pipe that was causing large sink holes. The fact is, the old pipe was perforated. This means it had small holes in it, designed to allow water to enter from basically anywhere. The new pipe is solid; therefore it does not have the perforations to capture water. The solid pipe we used was the best option for this application when looking at long term performance. Now we must simply add some small French drains to eliminate any standing water. I kindly ask everyone to avoid this area with carts.

We may need to delay play and/or utilize the mats at the driving range while frost becomes present as we move closer into winter. Frost delays protect the health of our turf and we ask that everyone would respect our decision to implement these delays. Please do not walk on the putting green when temperatures are below 32 degrees without first contacting the Pro Shop. Once we enter complete dormancy on our tees, fairways and rough, these delays will only be dictated by the amount of frost on our greens. My department will be in continuous contact with our Pro Shop to keep our members informed of these delays. Please feel free to contact me with any questions or concerns.
